



## GEORGIA

### CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Specifically permitted

Sparklers up to 100 grams each; fountains (items that say 'Emits Showers of Sparks' up to 200 grams total for multiple tube items or 75 grams for each individual tube; snakes, glow worms, snappers, party poppers.

Specifically prohibited

Firecrackers, torpedoes, sky rockets, roman candles, bombs, and sparklers.

### DISPLAY FIREWORKS

Display permit

Apply to local county at least 10 days before display date. \$10 fee, plus \$1 per copy of permit.

Insurance

Required. \$10,000 bond and insurance for bodily injury of at least \$25,000 for each person and \$50,000 for each accident, as well as property damage insurance of at least \$25,000 for each accident and \$50,000 aggregate. Insurance company must be licensed in Georgia.

Operator

License required by state law.

### MANUFACTURE, STORAGE, TRANSPORATION

Annual license fee for conducting business in the state: \$1,000. Expires Dec 31 each year.
