Specifically permitted May 20 –July 6 Ground based sparkling devices including fountains Dec. 10 – Jan. 3 multiple tube cake devices, illuminating torches,

wheels, and ground spinners

Specifically permitted year round Sparklers, smoker devices, and novelty devices

as defined in APA Std. 87-1 2001 edition.

Specifically prohibited Aerial consumer fireworks, bottle & sky rockets,

helicopters, torpedoes, roman candles & jumping

jacks.

<u>AERIAL CONSUMER, DISPLAY FIREWORKS</u> & PYROTECHNICS

Consumer Fireworks Permits Check local regulations for permit fees, zoning, and fire

Inspections.

Display Permits Fire Marshal has permit authority over all fireworks

and pyrotechnics displays & events on public school,

state, and country properties.

Insurance May be required by local authorities

Operator No license specifically required by state law but may

be required by local authorities.
